HARTE TO HARTE raced in midpack, closed six-wide late turn, bid a furlong out, dueled to the wire and prevailed under a drive. I'M CHIP, away slowly, settled off the pace, closed five-wide late turn, bid a furlong out, dueled to the end and just missed. RHYTHM OF ROCK stalked the pace, bid upper stretch, dueled briefly, was passed a furlong out and chased to the wire. GREEN FORESTER settled off the pace, closed outside rivals late turn then finished all out through the stretch. OPEN DOORS settled off the pace, closed five-wide late turn and rallied outside. SOROKOLITIS, in range early, settled in midpack at

the turn, chased into stretch and finished gamely. MOLINARO FT KNIGHT stalked the pace, chased late turn then evened out in deep stretch. BALSA led early, set a pressured pace, shook clear on the turn, was collared upper stretch and tired. FOREVER SMILE, away slowly, settled off the pace, was tentative behind the fading TOM'S CURFEW late turn, chased into the stretch but never reached contention. DARING DAN, in touch, chased four-wide on the turn then tired upper stretch. FLASHLIGHT HARRY, away alertly, stalked the pace, chased four-wide on the turn then tired in the stretch. TERRYBERRY, prominent on the backstretch, forced the pace into the turn, backed away and lacked a rally. TOM'S CURFEW forced the pace to the turn and tired.
