HANK'S HILL raced forwardly, edged clear on the main track, set a reserved pace then was all out in the stretch then was taken in hand near the wire. BATHSHEBA STATION, well back early, chased two-wide into the stretch then rallied along the rail. TOWN OF TOWNS, rated off the pace, was hustled and closed on the turn then chased gamely through the stretch. TYZACH broke outward, settled off the pace, closed three to five-wide on the turn and finished all out. LONESOME CHEROKEE stalked the pace in hand, chased three-wide into the stretch and evened out. CAPTAIN CHRIS, prominent early, stalked on the main track, chased four-wide into the stretch and tired. TIME FOR THE STARS steadied leaving the gate, raced off the pace, was hustled three-wide late turn then lacked a rally.
