REGAL SEN well placed inside, angled out approaching the sixteenth pole, rallied late four wide to get up in time. SENSUOUS CINNAMON had a short lead early, dueled three wide outside of ROYAL DAMSEL, gamely. VICTORY ROSE well placed three wide, advanced on the turn to make her bid, hung. ROYAL DAMSEL pressed the pace from off the rail early, dueled inside of the runner up, gave her best. TO THE CHAPEL stalked the duel from the inside, and was not a threat. ALOTTA SPIRIT stalked the duel from off the rail, and was not a factor. DANCE ME raced four wide, and showed little. FRUITS OF LABOUR always outrun.
