Footnotes

BELLAMY BLUES, in range, was hustled five-wide late turn, responded smartly at the head of the stretch, swept by the leader just into the final furlong and held under a drive. ROMANTIC SONG, away alertly, settled off the pace, chased six-wide late turn and finished determinedly. NARRATE broke outward, raced off the pace, was hustled seven-wide from the top of the stretch but evened out in the late stages. BAR IS OPEN bumped with a rival at the outset, showed brief speed then pressed the pace, chased close up on the turn then evened out in the stretch. WHY SO SOON had brief speed, forced the issue, bid midturn, dueled then drove clear upper stretch but was passed a furlong out and tired. NIAGARA EXPRESS bumped with a rival at the start, raced in range, chased two and three-wide on the turn then flattened out in the stretch. BOLD DASH showed speed, set a pressured pace, was engaged midturn, dueled, then tired upper stretch.
