RED EAGLE forced the pace, bid late turn, shook clear into the stretch and was kept to business to the wire. ROB THE CRADLE, in touch, angled three to six-wide through the turn, chased into the stretch then finished gamely. SUSTAINABLE FOREST bumped a rival leaving, led early, was headed midway of the backstretch, stalked the new leader, chased on the turn and finished gamely. CHIEF EXECUTIVE settled off the pace, was hustled angling from the rail to four-wide on the turn, moved back to the rail upper stretch and finished determinedly. RED SHOT broke outward, settled midpack, chased hard four to seven-wide on the turn but failed to menace. LITTLE MISTER WOO, bumped at the start, raced off the pace, angled three to six-wide through the turn then tendered a mild belated rally. EUCLID AVENUE bumped with a rival at the outset, raced in midpack,came three to eight-wide on the turn, chased into the stretch but was not a threat. NAMATH, in touch early between foes, faded on the turn and lacked a rally. FRIDAY NIGHT GUY was hustled in range early, chased hard on the turn then tired in the stretch. PEEKS INTHE FOREST, bumped at the start, forced the pace, bid midway of the backstretch, led into the turn, was headed late turn and tired in the stretch. MOONSHINE AMOUR, off slowly, raced midpack between foes, stopped sharply late backstretch and was eased.
