SWEET CASSIOPEIA led quickly, set a reserved pace, drifted five-wide late turn, widened under urging upper stretch and held sway under a strong hand ride. FAIRY FAMILIAR pressed the pace, was hustled on the turn, was forced out six-wide approaching the top of the stretch then chased to the wire. LEMON SPLASH raced off the pace, came four to six-wide through the turn, chased into the stretch and finished gamely. YANKEE CANDY stalked the pace, chased on the turn, was forced seven-wide at the top of the stretch then evened out in the final 16th. SEA GLITTER broke alertly but was rank briefly, settled off the pace, came three to seven-wide through turn and did not menace. DANGEROUS LOVER broke inward, raced in midpack, was hustled two to four-wide on the turn then evened out in the stretch. HEROIC CHARM stalked to late backstretch, backed away three-wide through the turn and lacked a closing response. HIGH TEE, well back throughout, was hustled on the turn but lacked a rally. WAITING FOR TIME gained contention on the backstretch, chased from the rail on the turn then tired in the stretch.
