WAR BEAU well placed inside, came off the rail into the stretch, rallied, altered course in the stretch, took over late. G. T.'S GONE WEST pressed the pace inside of BORNTOBELOVED, came three wide into the stretch, gained the lead in upper stretch, gave way late. FAR AND NEAR raced off the rail, gained mildly four wide. S N J'S DESIRE bumped at the start, trailed, passed tiring rivals. BORNTOBELOVED set a pressured pace from off the rail, came four wide into the stretch, and weakened. KNOWN PROSPECT bumped at the start, had a short lead early, pressed the pace three wide, and faded.
