ROYAL DISTRACTION raced off the pace, was hustled between foes on the turn and finished gamely. REPUTED DEEDS stalked from the rail, evened out in the stretch. SUNADIR trailed early, was hustled along the second path late turn and was all out through the stretch. ROWAN EXPRESS (GB) led quickly, set a reserved pace but tired upper stretch. DANA'S LUCKY LADY raced off the pace while three-wide, was roused at the top of the stretch then lacked a rally. MISTY EXPECTATION stalked the pace, chased on the turn then tired in the stretch. CITI MUSIC raced midpack along the rail, tired late turn.
