Footnotes

DEAD ON, rated in range, forced the pace from the rail into the turn, edged back a little, angled out sharply late turn, rallied smartly and swept to the lead in the late stages. ANY GIVEN ROYAL closed on the backstretch and forced the pace on the turn, challenged from the second path late turn, drove clear at the top of the stretch, had command to deep stretch and was passed. BILL OF RIGHTS settled at the back of the field, was hustled two to four-wide through the turn, angled out again in the stretch and launched a determined drive. PEYTON, prominent early, dueled four and five-wide on the turn, was headed at the top of the stretch, chased, but evened out in the late stages. DANGER BAY dueled three-wide, was headed at the top of the stretch, chased briefly and tired in the final furlong. GLOWING MONARCH, off a step slowly, stalked from between rivals, chased from the top of the stretch but flattened out in the final 16th. HURRY UP ALAN broke alertly, settled and stalked the pace, dropped back late turn and lacked a closing response. POLITICAL FEVER raced at the back of the pack, was hustled angling from three to eight-wide on the turn but had no response in the stretch.
