LORD OF THE REALM settled off the pace, closed between foes on the turn, rallied five-wide and got by late, driving. ECHO FLAT OUT, in range, closed between foes on the turn, led upper stretch then failed to hold late. FIRM BELIEVER raced in midpack, saved ground, chased into the stretch and finished gamely. MOLINARO PARTENZA stalked the pace, closed into the turn, bid late turn but was outkicked in the stretch. SAVE MY SOUL stalked the pace, closed into the turn, chased to the stretch then gave way grudgingly. MOON OVER L. A., away slowly, settled off the pace, was in range two-wide on the

turn then evened out in deep stretch. CHASING BRIDGET stalked the pace, was hustled four and five-wide on the turn, chased into the stretch but never reached contention. KANPAI settled in midpack, came four to six-wide through the turn but failed to menace. MIGHTY QUINN, off slowly, settled well back early, was hustled seven-wide through the turn then lacked a rally. WHISPER PLEASE sprinted clear, set the pace from the rail, was caught late turn and tired upper stretch. LORD OF ESSA settled off the pace, raced six-wide through the turn then lacked a closing response. A BIT OF DAN, away alertly, stalked the pace came five-wide through the turn but tired before reaching the stretch. HEIR GO settled off the pace, chased six-wide into the turn, angled inward to the second path but late turn and was never a threat.
