EXCITING STORY was in hand along the rail just off the lead of WESTFIELD, moved off the rail into the far turn and assumed command, opened a clear in the drive and prevailed under constant handling. TEMPERED APPEAL stalked the early pace between horses, roused three wide in the turn but was no match for the winner. GRAEME HALL was allowed to settle outside of rivals, moved to the rail in the turn and finished with a belated bid on the inside. WESTFIELD was rushed to the early lead but gave way into the far turn and faded. WORKED IN THE WIND was allowed to settle three wide and never rallied.
