**Footnotes**

EQUATORIAL stalked the early pace inside of rivals, angled out midway through the turn, assumed command in the final furlong and drew clear under steady pressure. MEE TOO was hustled along inside of rivals, dropped back on the turn, then came three wide entering the stretch and closed willingly. PROMISING WEST was unhurried early while racing off the rail, roused five wide on the turn and rallied belatedly. KRAYOLA bore out at the start and pressed the early pace three wide, assumed command on the turn and opened a length lead, but stopped in the final furlong and dropped back. DEPUTY'S LASS was allowed to settle outside of rivals, raced four wide on the turn and never rallied. KASHAGAWIGAMOG pressed the early pace from the rail, then tired in the stretch and faded. ROBYN'S SWEETEE showed brief speed between horses, then faltered entering the far turn and dropped back. STEVENSON'S ROCKET was void of early speed in the three path and outrun.
