CLAIR DE LUNE was full of run in the backstretch and closed the gap just off the rail inside of rivals, settled behind the leaders until the far turn, then split horses and assumed command entering the stretch, continued strong in the drive and drew off under steady pressure. ROYAL ATTRACTION was away alertly and dueled for the early lead in hand along the rail, roused entering the stretch, but was no match for the winner. ASMOKEAFTERDINNER was allowed to settle in the three path early, then roused on the second turn and finished with a mild bid. REGAL WINGS was in hand just off the rail close up, then dropped back in the stretch. KABEEB pressed the early pace three wide, then weakened in the drive. SWEET DREAMY SYN dueled for the early lead along the rail, then got tired in the stretch. AMBER JULE was unhurried early outside of rivals and never rallied. WARLIKE was checked hard entering the first turn, then dropped back and was eased.
