CAT N SASSY raced off the pace, was hustled along the rail through the turn, angled three-wide upper stretch, rallied and got up late under a drive. SEA SPICE forced the pace, bid late turn, dueled into the stretch, drove clear just into the final furlong but failed to contain the winner. LOUIE THE LIAR broke in the air, raced off the pace, angled from the third path to five-wide late turn, chased into the stretch but evened out late. TYPHOON TEMPEST led quickly, was headed early on the backstretch, chased three-wide on the turn, was all out at the top of the stretch then evened out. SWEEPING UPA STORM raced off the pace, was hustled three then four-wide on the turn, was blocked to midstretch then tendered a late rally between horses. BLACK RAPID raced off the pace, chased four-wide on the turn, came six-wide into the stretch but lacked a strong closing response. FLASHY TATTOO broke in the air, moved up quickly, took the lead and set a pressured pace, was engaged late turn, vied into the stretch and could no longer match strides and gave way. ROYAL PORTRUSH, in range along the rail, angled three-wide at the top of the stretch, chased to midstretch and tired.
