BIOFUEL, off a step slowly, raced well back, launched a furious drive on the far turn, bid a furlong out and drove clear. KITTY IN A TIZZY was close early, kept the pacesetter in her sights, chased late turn, bid a furlong out but was outkicked. BUBBLE GUM raced off the pace, chased hard late turn, launched an all out bid along the rail upper stretch but was no match for the top two but garnered third place. BARRACKS ROAD led early, widened on the first turn, was taken in hand and set a reserved pace, was roused upper stretch but tired a furlong out. DISTORTED LEGACY raced off the pace, came three and four-wide through the far turn then finished gamely to no avail. REDVERSE, close early, stalked the leader from a distance on the backstretch, chased through the turn to the stretch then flattened out. KAYCE ACE raced off the pace, angled from four to seven-wide on the far turn then lacked a rally. TIZAHIT raced off the pace, was hustled into the stretch but never reached contention.
