Footnotes

MARISA GO was off slowly and settled in the second flight along the rail, roused on the turn and assumed command entering the stretch, then held off JOLEY'S HONOR under strong steady pressure. The latter was allowed to settle off the rail, roused four wide on the turn and closed willingly outside of rivals. DECORIA was away alertly and pressed the early pace three wide, then weakened in late stretch. EDENS TRICK was void of early speed, roused off the rail on the turn and finished with a mild rally. PRINCESS REMAYAA was void of early speed off the rail and never rallied. ROBYN'S SWEETEE was hustled along pressing the early pace between horses, then tired in the drive. MAID TOUGH broke to the left and was void of early speed, never rallied and was never a factor. PROMISING WEST set a pressured pace inside of rivals, then stopped in the stretch and faded quickly.
