MULLIGAN THE GREAT broke sharply to gain a clear lead early, set a pressured pace three wide, drew clear on the turn, widened through the stretch under strong encouragement while drifting in. BRONZE BAYOU trailed three wide, rallied four wide, and was second best. MISTER COOP chased inside early, came off the rail at the five eighths pole to stalk the forced pace four wide, made a mild bid on the turn, and was outfinished for the place position. FORD EVERY STREAM well placed inside, and was not a factor. FRANK'S SELECTION pressed the pace from off the rail inside of the winner, gave way on the turn. STEADY RUCKUS well placed off the rail, and showed little.
