BESTOCATS, always in range, came four and five-wide through the turn, rallied and was just up, driving. SARATOGA BOY bid into the turn, moved clear, set the pace, ducked in upper stretch, was all out but failed to hold the winner safe. INSPIRED DEVIL raced in midpack, was hustled three-wide late turn then rallied gamely in vain. EXECUTIVE SHOPPER broke inward, raced in range five-wide on the turn then finished evenly. MERCY STREET settled in midpack, was hustled three-wide through the turn then moved to the rail upper stretch and finished gamely. RAGAMUFFIN raced off the pace, chased two-wide on the turn but lacked a strong closing response. BEN'S BEST BET broke inward, raced off the pace, chased five-wide on the turn, chased into the stretch and evened out. WHERE'S THE BAY was sent to the early lead, was headed early turn, chased, but tired midstretch. MIGHTY NIK raced off the pace, was hustled along the rail on the turn then lacked a closing response. BANKER LARRY raced off the pace, was hustled along the rail on the turn but never reached contention. LOVE IS GRAND settled off the pace, was hustled four-wide on the turn but lacked a rally.
