Footnotes

THE PREETZAH stalked the duelers, bid three-wide early on the final turn, vied, drove clear at the top of the stretch and widened under light handling. BRAHMS AFFAIR had rail speed, dropped back early backstretch to stalk, drove to the lead nearing the far turn, was headed, continued to chase gamely but was unable to close in the stretch. NEVER LEFT OUT vied two-wide, was headed, rebid early turn but yielded at the top of the stretch. KIRIS KISS, in touch three-wide, was roused late turn but never reached contention. DARK AND DANGEROUS raced off the pace between foes, was hustled along the rail on the far turn then evened out. TRIANGEL raced off the pace along the rail, was hustled through the far turn but lacked a strong closing response. MARIA BONITA, off a step slowly, forced the pace four-wide then three-wide on the first turn, dropped back nearing the final turn, was hustled along but tired.
