BIGASMAR raced off the pace, closed between rivals and angled out sharply late turn, rallied willingly and swept by the leader under a hand ride in midstretch. MALIBU SKYLINE sprinted clear early, set a reserved pace then failed to stave off the winner with a 16th to run. GAS N DASH settled in midpack, chased three to five-wide on the turn, finished gamely and got up late for the show. ONE BIG GATOR settled off the pace, was hustled on the turn, came seven-wide to the top of the stretch, finished gamely but did not threaten. FAYE'S GRAY settled off the pace, chased seven-wide late turn and rallied belatedly. DANIEL BE GOOD stalked the pace, chased two-wide late turn then evened out in the stretch. TUMERIC, well back early, was roused five-wide late turn then moved to the rail for the stretch run and rallied belatedly. RING OF GREATNESS raced off the pace, was hustled three and four-wide on the turn but evened out in the stretch. ALIMIN raced in midpack, was hustled three to six-wide on the turn then evened out in the late stages. PASSAGER (FR) settled off the pace, chased hard four to six-wide on the turn then flattened out in the stretch. KIRKLAND LAKE stalked the pace, chased three-wide late turn then tired in the stretch. CLASSICAL MELODY raced in midpack, saved ground, was hustled late turn but flattened out in the stretch. ESSENCE THUNDER raced off the pace, closed three-wide late turn, moved to the rail at the top of the stretch but lacked a closing rspns. MAKAR, in range, chased two-wide early turn and tired.
