UP WITH THE BIRDS broke a bit inward, raced off the early pace, closed three and four-wide on the far turn, bid a furlong out, drove clear and finished under a strong hand ride. COWDRAY PARK set a pressured pace, shook clear into the stretch, was engaged a furlong out but was no match for the winner while best of the rest. MOM'S SONG, rated off the pace, saved ground on the far turn then chased through the stretch. BOOKIES NIGHTMARE, squeezed back at the start, settled in midpack, was hustled through the far turn then finished gamely in vain. TRADE RUMOR, under strong restraint early, was steadied along the rail behind a rival running into the far turn, stalked, came off the rail entering the top of the stretch then moved back to the rail and was all out but ran out of steam in the late stages. APOSTOLIC forced the pace, was hustled on the far turn, was steadied in tight at the top of the stretch then chased to the end. HARLAN'S VITESSE, rated off the pace, was hustled two and three-wide through the far turn then tired at the top of the stretch. A CLAIM OF FOUL BY THE RIDER ON APOSTOLIC AGAINST TRADE RUMOR AND UP WITH THE BIRDS FOR INTERFERENCE AT THE TOP OF THE STRETCH RESULTED IN TRADE RUMOR BEING DISQUALIFIED AND PLACED SIXTH.
