Footnotes

WILD FLYER stalked the early pace 3 wide, drew even around the turn, assumed command in upper stretch and drew clear under left handed urging. KNOTTY MASK broke sharply but stumbled a few jumps out and dropped back, settled off the rail in the backstretch, closed the gap 4 wide in the turn but couldn't stay with the winner in the drive. PRIDE OF DIABLO pressed the early pace from the rail, weakened in the drive but battled gamely and prevailed for show. PORT MARIA was hustled along and vied for the lead between horses then weakened in the stretch. ASSET VALUE (IRE) stalked the early pace just off the rail, lugged out through the turn and steadied to the stretch, was never a threat after that. TO BE TRUE showed brief speed 3 wide then weakened in the turn and dropped back. FLYING TABRIZ lost his action at the 3/8 pole and steadied, moved to the rail in the turn and jumped a shadow, was then eased in the stretch.
