Footnotes

GORILLA MY DREAMS gained a short lead in the first turn and was in hand between horses, responded well entering the stretch and drew clear under steady pressure. RICH MIST was allowed to settle just off the rail, roused along the rail on the turn, came behind a wall in the drive and had to alter course with a furlong to go, then closed fast outside of rivals. ROYAL DALLIANCE was unhurried early just off the rail, roused three wide on the turn and finished with a mild bid. BRANKSOME HALL was allowed to settle outside of rivals, closed the gap four wide on the turn, but flattened out in the drive. CASSIA was in hand along the rail pressing the early pace, then tired in the stretch and dropped back. COSA RARA was allowed to settle just off the rail, roused along the rail in the second turn, but was never a factor. ROYAL JADE was close up three wide in the early going, but got tired after four furlongs and faded.
