Footnotes

MISS GRINDSTONE showed speed then settled and stalked the duelers, bid three-wide at the top of the stretch, drove clear quickly then held under a drive. ROYAL DISTRACTION in touch but off the pace, closed between horses late turn, was blocked briefly early stretch then rallied gamely when clear. VROOM HILDA raced forwardly, settled and stalked three-wide on the turn, closed four-wide approaching the stretch, was determined to the late stages then evened out. ONE FOR KATIE dueled outside GREATTOBELOVED then weakened in the stretch. GREATTOBELOVED vied from the outset, stayed gamely inside ONE FOR KATIE to upper stretch and gave way. HALIBURTON HONEY stalked the pace, was roused three-wide midturn then flattened out in the stretch. SILVER CHAMP was in touch from the outset, saved ground but lacked a rally.
