Footnotes

BID FOR SILVER set a pressured pace, moved clear into the far turn then widened under a hand ride. BUNNY LAKE stalked from the outside, chased hard between foes on the far turn but hung in the stretch. FOXY JEAN rated along the rail, closed on the fourth path through the far turn, was roused but hung in the stretch. JOVITE stalked along the rail, chased on the far turn, evened out in the stretch. BEYOND THE HORIZON, in touch early, was hustled between foes late on the backstretch, faded on the turn then lacked a rally. SOX IT TO ME, always well off the pace, raced five-wide on the first turn and three-wide on the far turn and was never a threat. MANZEE BLUE forced the pace, chased hard on the far turn and tired.
