SPEED RING kept in touch and was inside on the turn, angled out, bid then finished with good energy to prevail clear of the rest. RIOPELLE up on the pace, battled into and through the turn, had the lead in early stretch then was no match for the winner but held the place. I WANT YOU TO KNOW never far back, was outside on the turn then came home with a mild bid to best the others. TIPPERARY DAVOR in mid field, bid from the four path into the stretch but did not have enough to catch the top three. OBAN had a wide trip and was off the pace into the turn before getting it together and putting in a belated try. MOBILIST had speed and led briefly, vied through the turn then faded in the run to the wire. REIGNERS LANE was off a step slow, moved into contention inside, saved ground then had no stretch kick. MINGUNS PROSPECT was off the pace in a wide trip and never a factor.
