IWILLGOTOTHEMOON made a good middle move to challenge thee wide for the lead, vied on the turn the was outdone for the place spot late. SPORTS SELECT had good speed to vie outside the leader, then was inside and battling entering the stretch then tired. OCCASIONAL VIEW tracked the leaders and was in the hunt behind the speed duel on the turn then lacked a finish. THE BOY'S RING in mid field, lacked the needed bid and was not a stretch factor. D'ORO DIABLO had speed to lead then vie inside of foes for a half before fading. QUEEN STREET BEACH trailed and showed little.
