STAKES Mazarine Breeders' Cup S. Grade 3 - Thoroughbred

FOR TWO-YEAR-OLD FILLIES. By subscription of \$250 each which shall accompany the nomination and an additional \$2,500 when making entry; with \$175,000 added and an additional \$75,000 from the Breeders' Cup Fund for Cup nominees only, plus \$50,000 for Ontario Breds from the Thoroughbred Improvement Program and Canadian Thoroughbred Horse Society. The host association's added monies and all fees to be divided: 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Breeders' Cup Fund monies correspondingly divided provided a Breeders' Cup nominee has finished in an awarded position. Any Breeders' Cup Fund monies not awarded will revert back to the fund. Weight 120 lbs. Winners of a sweepstakes of \$75,000 at a mile or over, or a sweepstakes of \$75,000 three times at any distance, additional 2 lbs.; Non-winners of a sweepstakes of \$75,000 twice at any distance, allowed 3 lbs.; Of a sweepstakes of \$75,000 once, 5 lbs.; Of a race other than claiming, 7 lbs. (No Canadian Bred Allowance) Closed September 14th with 16 nominations.

Footnotes

KNIGHTS TEMPLAR led quickly, set a reserved pace, was lightly asked upper stretch then widened steadily under a hand ride. SUDSY BABY gained steadily to the far turn, continued to advance along the rail then was all out for second. TOP NOTCH LADY stalked the pace from the second path, could not stay close late turn and was all out in the stretch. MOTEL DANCING raced midpack, saved ground but was never in contention. CLASSICAL MISS stalked

three-wide, was hustled through the far turn then lacked a rally. TROUT RIVER RED trailed early, passed tiring horses. ONE RING raced midpack, raced three-wide through the first turn, saved ground on the far turn but lacked a rally. TASHA'S DELIGHT raced midpack, was five-wide on the first turn and two-wide on the far turn then flattened out. ARRAVALE, in touch early, could not stay close and faded three-wide late turn. SILENT COURSE rated early between foes, was always far back and lacked a rally. FRIVOLETTE, four-wide on the first turn and three-wide on the far turn, showed little.
