SHILLELAGH SLEW forced the pace on the backstretch, bid outside GOOD AND LUCKY early turn, dueled, wore that one down a furlong out and drove clear. ITALIANO broke alertly, stalked three-wide, closed along the fourth path on the turn and bid at the top of the stretch but was no match for the winner. GOOD AND LUCKY took a short lead, set a pressured pace, dueled through the turn then gave way at the 1/8 pole. DAKOTA FREEWAY stalked from the rail then came up empty when asked in upper stretch. HIGHLAND GLORY stalked between foes, flattened out in the final furlong. SKIPPED BAIL broke in the air, raced well off the pace then lacked a rally. SAMARCOS (BAR) was through early and faded.
