RISE TO GLORY vied for the lead and was three wide into stretch while battling, then led and was kept to task. BIG BREECHES in striking distance, came on to wide into the stretch, rallied willingly but could not reach the winner. SIR MCINTYRE tracked the leaders, bid inside into the stretch, looked a danger then evened out. STUNNING SPLIT was outside foes then a factor into the stretch but lacked the needed finish. ENCYCLICAL on pace and in touch through the turn, lacked a serious stretch bid. CREEPING BARRAGE had good off rail speed, vied into the stretch then weakened in the drive. FRANKLY was well off the pace and never a threat. S S RAPHAEL unhurried early, rated well back, stayed there and was never close and never a factor. ROYAL COLWOOD backed away and trailed the field home.
