PRESS EXCLUSIVE set the early pace in hand, opened a clear lead on the turn and prevailed under strong urging. TACKY AFFAIR stalked the early pace from just off the rail, roused in upper stretch and closed willingly under strong pressure. EMILYNA was allowed to settle between horses and finished evenly. ROMAN ROMANCE pressed the early pace inside of rivals, then weakened in the stretch. FLEUR DE SEL was allowed to settle just off the rail, then roused three wide on the turn, but was never a threat. VIXEN STAR bobbled at the start and void of early speed along the rail, never rallied and was never a threat.
