SOUTHDALE, in touch and in hand early, stalked from the inside, was in tight inside the leader at the top of the stretch, got room and bid upper stretch and quickly moved clear then finished under a hand ride. BARRELING HOME set a pressured pace, was hustled late turn, was headed upper stretch and chased to the end. STUNNING STAG, in range outside rivals, chased five-wide late turn then rallied gamely. POOL PLAY, in range between foes, angled three to seven-wide through the far turn then finished determinedly. PALLADIO, rated in range, closed five-wide into the far turn, chased and was close up but evened out in deep stretch. EYE OF THE LEOPARD forced the pace, chased hard late turn, showed no response when roused and gave way.
