Footnotes

SMOOCHEr bumped with SAN DIEGO BLOWOUT heading into the first turn, angled in to race along the rail, rallied to gain command in upper stretch and drifted out, jumped tracks approaching the sixteenth pole while drawing off. ORGAN GRINDER stalked the forced pace three wide, advanced four wide on the second turn, gained late to get up for the place position. NIIGON trailed early, was well placed inside, came out three wide on the second turn, moved back in heading into the stretch, advanced and was outfinished for the place position. TWISTED WIT stalked the forced pace from off the rail, advanced three wide on the second turn to make a bid outside of ESTEVAN, flattened out in the stretch. ESTEVAN had a clear lead on the first turn, was under pressure from SAN DIEGO BLOWOUT in the backstretch while off the rail, gave way into the stretch. TOBE SUAVE swung a little wide into the first turn and bumped with SILVER TICKET, dropped back heading into the backstretch, moved inside on the second turn, passed tiring rivals in the stretch. SILVER TICKET was bumped by TOBE SUAVE and steadied on the first turn, raced three wide, and showed little. BACHELOR BLUES was bumped by SILVER TICKET and steadied on the first turn, raced four wide, and faded. SAN DIEGO BLOWOUT was unprepared for the start and broke slow, was between horses and bumped with the winner into the first turn, advanced on the first turn to press the pace outside of ESTEVAN while three wide, gave way on the second turn, and faded.
