WOOKIN TO RUN had an awkward start, raced well back early, angled from the rail to three-wide closing on the turn, rallied,willingly and just got up, driving. DAD'S FISHING set a pressured pace, shook clear late turn,and just failed to stay. NORTHERN GATER stalked from the rail, was all out in the stretch but missed. REGALLY RED raced midpack along the rail, moved two-wide late turn then hung in the stretch. SUN AFTER NOON raced off the pace along rail, was hustled upper stretch then evened out. PRATTLE raced midpack, closed five-wide late turn then evened out. FLASHY N CLASSY had brief speed, chased four-wide on the turn then flattened out. CELERITY'S SUMMIT forced the pace, gave way late turn and tired in the stretch. BANAGHER JR. forced the pace three-wide, was hustled into the stretch and tired. FENDER BENDER, off slowly, was always well back and lacked a rally. A STEWARDS' INQUIRY INTO THE START REGARDING WOOKIN TO RUN LEFT THE RESULTS AS POSTED.
