### Footnotes

THE BOY'S RING raced off the pace, closed four and five-wide through the turn, bid upper stretch then gradually gained the lead under a drive. GAS N DASH had early speed, dueled into the turn, gave way a bit then rebid at the top of the stretch, dueled, was headed late but held second. IWILLGOTOTHEMOON had speed, dueled and gained a narrow lead midturn, was engaged at the top of the stretch, dueled then gave way grudgingly. AREPEATEE showed brief speed, took back from the duel, stalked the pace, chased late turn then evened out in the stretch. NERONE raced off the pace, angled from three to five-wide on the turn, was roused at the top of the stretch, finished gamely but did not threaten. FREDDIE ANTEROS, in range and in hand early, chased into the stretch but evened out in the late stages.
