COLINS NIGHTINGALE settled off the pace, closed on the far turn, rallied wide and got up late under a drive. CHARISMATICALLY raced off the pace, was hustled through the far turn, bid at the top of the stretch and drove clear then failed to hold near the wire. ME AND A BREEZE, bothered at the start and well back early, closed late turn and finished determinedly. LIONS SUMMIT, well back early, closed on the far turn but evened out in deep stretch. GOLDEN GILDA raced off the pace, closed on the far turn then flattened out in the stretch. CHASING VICTORIA stalked the pace, closed on the turn, had command at the top of the stretch, was quickly headed and tired. BUCK HUNTER stalked the pace, closed on the far turn then tired in the stretch. BARE HUMOR raced off the pace, was hustled on the final turn but tired in the stretch. ARCTIC CROWN, off slowly and well back early, was hustled along the rail through the far turn then flattened out in the stretch. CROATIAN DIVA stalked the pace, was hustled on the far turn but tired at the top of the stretch. SHESACUTIE

sprinted to a clear lead, set the pace, was hustled on the far turn but was caught at the top of the stretch and tired. LIFTOFF LADY broke outward, stalked the leader into the backstretch, began to back away, was eased on the turn and pulled up at the top of the stretch.
