KISS A NATIVE was allowed to settle outside of rivals just off the lead, roused under left handed urging on the turn, but lost ground entering the stretch, continued under strong urging through the drive, then got up in the final strides after a long sustained drive. MILWAUKEE BREW was unhurried early just off the rail, angled outside of rivals approaching the far turn and made a quick move four wide, drew even outside of GANDRIA entering the stretch and dueled to the wire, prevailed in the battle against the filly, but was outfinished by the winner KISS A NATIVE. GANDRIA was taken back and moved to the rail in the first turn, then stalked the pace under a tight hold in the backstretch, drew even on the turn and dueled inside of MILWAUKEE BREW through the stretch, but lost that battle and ended up third when the latter was caught at the wire. SIX FIFTEEN was away alertly and set a pressured pace just off the rail, then faltered on the turn and faded. THE FED pressed the early pace three wide, then tired on the turn and dropped back.
