SOUTHEY gained a short lead in the first turn and set the early pace in hand, opened a length advantage approaching the far turn and continued strong in the drive under mild urging. AMERICAN SKIPPER was unhurried early along the rail, roused inside of rivals on the turn, edged off the rail entering the stretch and finished well. DANCE ACADEMY pressed the early pace from the three path, started to tire on the turn and was under right handed urging then dropped back in the drive. WEST MADISYN was allowed to settle in the three path and lacked a late response. ROSHARON was void of early speed, roused three wide on the turn and was never a factor. LALKA stalked the early pace inside of rivals, then dropped back in the second turn and was outrun. SONG FORUM was unhurried early and eased in the backstretch then galloped around to the finish.
