Footnotes

ALMOSTOUTOFTHEBLUE sprinted clear quickly, was joined and dueled from early turn, shook clear at the top of the stretch and held under a drive. GULCH KNIGHT, in range between horses, closed three-wide late turn and finished determinedly. PHOR PHILIPPE settled off the pace, was hustled two-wide late turn, finished all out but did not threaten. CANDY GAMES, in touch, chased two-wide late turn then flattened out in the final 16th. BORDER CUVEE raced off the pace, saved ground, angled out between rivals at the top of the stretch, finished all out but did not threaten. FLESHNER raced off the pace, was hustled four-wide late turn but never reached contention. GRAN PATRON, off a step slowly, moved up quickly between rivals to stalk on the backstretch, bid early turn, dueled to the top of the stretch and tired. PEDEGRAL, in range between horses, angled from two to four-wide through the turn, chased into the stretch but tired in the final furlong.
