### Footnotes

TAPIA, bumped at the start then squeezed back, raced off the pace, closed two and three-wide on the turn, rallied willingly outside and got by late, driving. COASTAL TIDE, bumped at the start, sprinted clear late backstretch, set the pace, was joined in the final furlong, battled to a narrow advantage but was caught late. PENELOPUS stalked the pace, lapped on the leader midturn, was headed at the top of the stretch, launched an all out drive and rebid but gave way grudgingly. ENDLESS APPROVAL, forced out at the start, settled in range, came two to four-wide through the turn then finished evenly. CLASSICAL HUMOUR stalked the pace from the rail, chased through the stretch then evened out in the late stages. MS SILVER OAK raced in midpack, came two and three-wide through the turn, chased into the stretch but offered no late response. DRACUP, well back early, was hustled along the rail on the turn but never reached contention. VARIABLE RATE broke outward, settled off the pace, closed to midpack on the turn then evened out along the rail in the stretch. CLEAR MARCH raced in midpack along the rail, chased into the stretch then evened out in the late stages.
