FLASHY MARINA dueled along the rail with ONCE SILVER for the early lead, put that one away in the drive and drew clear under intermittent urging. PROMISING WEST was in hand 3 wide, roused in the turn and finished well. ONCE SILVER showed good early speed and dueled outside of the winner then tired in the drive. CURIOUS CALL was hustled along off the rail, made a mild bid in the stretch but was never a threat. SEATTLE PRIME was hustled along just off the rail between horses and ran evenly. LITTLE VIRAGO was hustled along pressing the early pace along the rail then tired. EXPLOSEFA was void of early speed along the rail and was outrun. PORT MARIA showed no speed and was never a factor.
