CASIMIRO stalked the pace from the rail, closed upper stretch, bid nearing midstretch, quickly took command and held, driving. ORIENTATE SLEW was hustled to a short lead, was quickly headed, forced the pace, bid midstretch but was outkicked. MYMAMADONTDANCE raced off the pace, was hustled three to five-wide on the turn, lugged in through the stretch but continued to gain. D'WILD MAN raced off the pace, was hustled from well back on the turn then closed gamely in vain. PAKULA took the lead early backstretch, set a pressured pace, shook clear at the top of the stretch, was headed near midstretch and tired. MEDIDOCIHOSPISURG raced off the pace, was hustled through the turn then tendered a mild rally inside. EXCHANGE BANDIT stalked the pace, closed into the turn, chased to the stretch but tired in the late stages.
