RED SOX FOX raced midpack, was hustled on the far turn, rallied six-wide, bid a furlong out and moved clear then held under a brisk hand ride in the final yards. ZIPPY LADY broke outward, raced off the pace, was roused late turn and rallied five-wide. IMANUPTOWNGIRL chased late turn, bid late turn, vied into the stretch, led briefly but was headed then chased the leader home. BORN TO STORM raced off the pace, was hustled on the far turn angling three to six-wide and rallied from far back. WHOS HOT NOW dropped back early, closed on the far turn, bid near the 1/4 pole, was headed at the 1/8 pole then evened out late. DIVORSKY broke a bit in the air, remained unhurried then was hustled on the far turn but evened out in the stretch. MALLORY led quickly, set a reserved pace, was caught late turn, dueled, and tired in the final furlong. POBRECITA stalked early but dropped back early backstretch, was eased on the far turn and pulled up at the top of the stretch. A STEWARDS' INQUIRY INTO THE START FOUND THAT DIVORSKY HAD RECEIVED AN UNFAIR START NECESSITATING A REFUND.
