CROWN'S PATH, in range on the backstretch, remained patient while the leader drew away on the turn then chased all out in the stretch and got by in the final furlong. CONTROL settled off the pace, closed late turn and finished all out between rivals. NINE WINDS raced in midpack, saved ground on the turn then rallied gamely. OPENING MEET bobbled slightly leaving, settled in midpack, chased into the stretch but evened out in the late stages. KHULNA set a reserved early pace, widened to a long lead on the turn then tired in midstretch and was passed in the final furlong. VALID'S BEST raced off the pace, was hustled six-wide late turn and rallied mildly. SIR ADIE raced off the pace between foes then lacked a serious stretch response. SIR ANDREW stalked the pace, chased three-wide late turn then flattened out in the late stages. SPANISH PLAYBOY broke awkwardly and dropped back, came two-wide through the

turn and was never in contention. CAPTAIN CROW raced in midpack, was hustled six-wide late turn then evened out in the final furlong. PEACE BAY settled off the pace, was hustled into the stretch and tired. PLEASURE PEAKS, up close early, stalked from afar on the turn then tired in the stretch. THE ACID TEST, well back throughout, lacked a rally. MOLINARO REMARKS stalked the pace then tired late turn.
