SAUCY SONG, clear briefly, was joined in a duel midbackstretch, wore down that rival late turn, was headed at the top of the stretch, rebid midstretch and drove clear. DUBAI DOT broke outward, stalked the pace, bid along the rail late turn, shook clear at the top of the stretch, was engaged near the 16th pole and gave way grudgingly. BOND'S BABE raced in midpack, was hustled two and three-wide on the turn, chased into the stretch and finished gamely. TWIST OF SILVER, off slowly and rated off the pace, was hustled three-wide late turn and finished all out. I'M NOT AFRAID broke inward, settled in midpack, closed four-wide late turn then evened out in the final 16th. STRIKING MISS, off slowly, moved up and dueled from midbackstretch, forced the pace to late turn then tired upper stretch. AMERICAN CASTLE, rated off the pace, came three and four-wide on the turn, was roused at the top of the stretch but showed no response.
