Footnotes

DIAMONDSFORA LADY closed three-deep late turn, rallied determinedly in the stretch and got by SPANISH BRANDY in the late stages. SPANISH BRANDY dueled from the rail, wore down COUSIN SALLY in the late stages but had already been passed by the winner. COUSIN SALLY stalked the pace, closed three-wide on the turn, bid approaching the stretch, dueled to the late stages and weakened. MARIA CLARISSA close early, settled, closed late turn along the rail, was blocked a furlong out and finished evenly. WOODEN SHIPS well back early, saved ground then rallied mildly. IMPRESSARIA was squeezed back at the start, advanced gradually on the second path but never reached contention. NEON BRIGHT stalked the pace, closed four-wide late turn then flattened out in the stretch. CONGENIAL SPOT raced midpack three-wide and lacked a rally. WILD ATTRACTION saved ground, launched her bid at the top of the stretch, was in striking position but tired with a furlong to run. ALWAYS HOPE broke outward, showed speed and dueled outside SPANISH BRANDY to late turn and tired.
