SIR BLITZ stalked three-deep, bid upper stretch and drove clear. SEEKING THE CARAT, unhurried early, closed into the stretch then rallied late between foes. AS EXPECTED dueled early, gained a narrow lead upper stretch but gave way grudgingly. FOLLOW THE SUN dueled from the rail, was very game upper stretch then gave way grudgingly. GREAT ADDICTION stalked the pace between foes, lacked a strong closing response. ARE YOU SERIOUS settled quickly, saved ground, was hustled upper stretch but did not threaten. DASHING ADMIRAL, in touch from the outside, closed four-wide late turn then flattened out. D C'S THUNDER, in touch three-deep, flattened out at the top of the stretch.
