BRIDGEBURNER forced the pace on the backstretch, stalked on the turn, chased through the stretch and got up late, driving. TOM JOY, in range outside, came three to six-wide through the turn, launched an all out charge and just missed. VENTURE EXCHANGE set a pressured pace, was engaged near the top of the stretch, dueled, gained a short lead but weakened in the late stages. ORIGINAL CAST, bumped from both sides at the start, chased five-wide into the stretch and finished gamely. NO APPRECIATION settled in range, chased late turn, bid along the rail at the top of the stretch, vied briefly and gave way. LIFE FACTOR raced in midpack, was hustled late turn but did not threaten. NO EXCHANGES settled off the pace, was hustled on the turn but never reached contention. WHOAN COLORADO, well back early, was hustled angling from three to six-wide through the turn then evened out in deep stretch. SEWANEE, bumped at the start, settled well back, was roused repeatedly early turn, chased five-wide but failed to threaten. CLASSIC BRYCE raced off the pace, was hustled two to four-wide on the turn then lacked a rally. SMASHING PROMISE, bumped at the start, chased on the turn then tired upper stretch.
