LEMON SPLASH, in touch, chased five-wide into the stretch, rallied smartly and got up late, driving. HENNY BLUES forced the pace, bid late turn, led at the top of the stretch then failed to contain the winner in the late stages. ATHENA ROSE settled off the pace, saved ground, chased into the stretch but evened out late. KAWAGUCHI raced in midpack, chased on the turn, bid late turn, was headed at the top of the stretch and chased to the end. WOODBINE KITTEN stalked three-wide, bid late turn but failed to sustain the drive in the stretch. FLYING ARCH settled off the pace, chased four and five-wide on the turn, bid near the 1/4 pole, was headed at the top of the stretch and flattened out. RETURN ENGAGEMENT set a pressured pace, was engaged late turn then headed at the top of the stretch and tired. WAITING FOR TIME raced in midpack, came three and four-wide on the turn then lacked a rally. QUICKLIME, off slowly, raced off the pace, came three to six-wide through the turn and tired.
