KARLIE'S HOLIDAY, rated off the pace, was hustled two and three-wide on the far turn, cut inwards approaching the top of the stretch, rallied and got by late under a hand ride. PLEASANTFRIDAY stalked the pace, drew even briefly early backstretch, stalked into the far turn, chased hard from midturn, drove clear at the top of the stretch then failed to contain the winner in the late stages. GRAND STYLE settled off the pace, closed angling from four to seven-wide on the turn then rallied gamely. GOOD LADY, rated off the pace, was hustled three-wide late turn but evened out in the stretch. PULLING FOR DIXIE, in range early, moved up close early backstretch then was hustled angling from three to six-wide on the turn but evened out in the stretch. DECKER WEST, in range, dropped back on the backstretch, was hustled through the far turn then evened out in the stretch. ATHENE held a brief lead, was headed at the first turn and stalked the pacesetter, was roused late turn but had no response and tired. KALAMBAKA QUEEN led on the first turn, shook clear late backstretch, was headed late turn and tired.
